



Dress Code

The Wesley Communities is a professional environment which requires a dress code.

Anyone who is out of uniform will be sent home. After three (3) violations, the volunteer will be dropped from the program.

You will be provided a volunteer tee shirt to wear during all in-person volunteering.

Your photo identification badge must be worn at shoulder height during your volunteer shift. You must wear black or khaki colored slacks and shoes covering your entire foot. All clothes should be clean and pressed. Hair longer than shoulder length should be pulled back. Perfume, jewelry, and facial ornamentation should be kept to a minimum. Nails must be kept short. No visible tattoos. Fads (such as colored hair mousse, vibrant nail polish, body piercings, etc.) are not appropriate.

No jeans, denims, shorts, leggings, oversized pants, sweats, sandals, flip flops, or open toes shoes are allowed.
